
The NEET population is currently at 2.9% compared to 2.6% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 10.3%, compared to 7.8% at the same time last year. The Participation rate is 85.1%, compared to 86.6% the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.7% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.3% in Dover. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 6.8% in Thanet to 13.2% in Maidstone & Sevenoaks.

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to collect data from all education establishments regarding offers they have made to 16- and 17-year olds from September. It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to identify those at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.

Please note the Kent and district NEET Y12 & Y13 targets have been updated to the September 2022 figures.






Current Month Target Comparison



SEND NEET and Not Known Breakdown






Youth Offending Team NEET and Not Known Breakdown


