Thanks to funding from the Big Lottery Fund, we are pleased to make the Wellbeing Measurement Framework available **free of charge** to schools across England.

The **Wellbeing Measurement Framework** is a set of validated measures assessing children's emotional wellbeing, mental health issues, coping strategies and risk and resilience factors. It can be completed online by young people in school.

It has been developed as part of the HeadStart programme, a long term programme funded by the Big Lottery Fund trialling a broad range of initiatives across the country for improving resilience and emotional wellbeing in 10-16 year olds.

The WMF is suitable for use with young people in primary (years 5 and 6) and secondary schools in England and we can offer guidance on how to implement it effectively.

How we can help?

We are offering a support package for up to 130 schools for free. This includes:

- support in administering a consent process for participating pupils
- access to the electronic survey
- analysis of survey responses from your school, benchmarked with schools from other areas
