
The NEET population is currently at 2.5% compared to 2.3% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 18.2%, compared to 17.8% at the same time last year. The Participation rate is 78.2%, compared to 77.8% the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.5% in Tunbridge Wells to 3.9% in Dover. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 12.8% in Canterbury to 25.6% in Swale.

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to collect data from all education establishments regarding offers they have made to 16- and 17-year olds from September. It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to identify those at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.

Please note the Kent and district NEET Y12 & Y13 targets have been updated to the September 2022 figures.
