The NEET population is currently at 4.0% compared to 3.4% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 3.9%, compared to 1.6% at the same time last year. The Participation rate is 89.0%, compared to 90.7% the same point last year.


District performance for NEET varies from 2.5% in Tunbridge Wells to 5.1% in Swale. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 1.7% in Thanet to 5.1% in Folkestone & Hythe.

It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. 




SEND NEET and Not Known Breakdown






Youth Offending Team NEET and Not Known Breakdown


