VSK Advisory Team

Working together to promote positive educational outcomes for children who have needed the support of a social worker. Interactive video course.

It has always been important for children and young people that the adults around them work together and have a shared understanding and language about the needs of the child. We are living through a prolonged collective trauma which has a significant impact on mental health and wellbeing for everyone in the community. Collective trauma requires collective recovery. So, it is not just important, it is essential that adults who work with children and young people and their families can work together with shared understanding and shared language.

This short interactive video course is designed to be accessible for busy people, and to promote discussions with others in the network around vulnerable children. We would recommend accessing this together, in groups, as the content encourages rich discussions. However, it can also be completed individually, making notes in the integral journal which can then be printed to share with others in discussion.

East Kent Schools. Supporting Sensory Needs in the Classroom training, 4th July 2023 Venue TBC.

Children who have experienced Developmental Trauma can often present with Sensory Processing issues which can be misinterpreted as general behavioural problems, ADHD or ASD. By understanding the child's sensory needs, and developing sensory regulating strategies, schools can begin to dampen down over-responsive senses and activate under-responsive ones **within** the classroom.

This free in-person training has been developed by Kent Education Psychology Service, STLS, VSK and Adoption Partnership South East. It is aimed at all mainstream schools in East Kent wanting to learn how to support the regulation of their young people, **within** the classroom.
