The first part is an overview of the statutory requirements of this return followed by the opportunity to see how to prepare and extract data required for the SWC from SIMS before submitting to the Local Authority or the DfE. Delegates do not need to have previously run a SWC however a working knowledge of SIMS Personnel is desirable. This workshop is ideal for those staff mentioned above who are new to the School Workforce Census or who would like a refresher on how to complete this annual return.
